

35' FISHING VESSEL

Construction: Aluminum~ 34' to 37'

Design no. 86-341

This design was developed for the fishery on the west coast of North America and has proven to be an excellent sea boat in locales ranging from California to the Alaska Gulf. Power is by 300 hp single diesel.

The fish hold is divided into 3 holds to minimise free surface effect and there are fish boxes in way of the drum. Alternate hold arrangements can be adopted to suit the owner's requirements.

Construction is of welded aluminum with a bottom of 1/4" plate (3/8" plate aft) over transverse and longitudinal frames. Hull sides, decks, and superstructure are built to similar tough standards to give years of trouble free service.

The interior layout illustrated is but one of several that can be fitted to suit the owner's needs. Shown is a custom layout arranged with permanent berth for 1 person and an adjacent 'head' in the foc'sle. The main cabin features a full galley and dinette area.
